

## Post Secondary Admission

Students planning to enter a post secondary institution need to consider entrance requirements:

1. B. C. High School Graduation;
2. General admission requirements to a post-secondary institution;
3. Admission to a specific program;
4. Scholarships available.

### Institutions outside B. C.

Students should **NOT** assume that post-secondary institutions outside B. C. have the same admission requirements as those within B. C. Information is available in our Career Centre.

### Camosun College and other Community Colleges

1. Admission requirements are program specific. Students must check the specific requirements for the program in which they are interested.
2. C+ in English 12 is a general requirement, however some departments only require a C in English 12.
3. Please check math requirements for specific programs

1. B. C. High School Graduation. The **minimum** average is calculated on the grade 12 subjects required for admission listed by each faculty. The actual average required to be offered admission may be higher than the minimum published average due to limits on enrollment.
2. English 12 plus 3 approved academic courses.

## Post Secondary Admission continued

### University Of British Columbia

1. B. C. High School Graduation;
2. English 11, Social Studies 11, Lab Science 11, Math 11, a language 11 (A beginners language 11 does not satisfy this requirement)
3. English 12 plus 3 grade 12 approved academic courses
4. All students must have completed a Language Proficiency Index (LPI). A minimum score of level 5 is required on the essay section of the test. Students whose LPI scores are below the level required for entrance into first year English courses are encouraged to take a non-credit writing course through the University Writing Centre to assist them in achieving a satisfactory LPI score.

2. There have been major changes to entrance requirement. Students need to check requirements in the Simon Fraser calendar or viewbook, both are available in the Career Centre.

For students who are considering attending B.C.I.T. it is recommended they consult entrance requirements. These are on file in our Career Centre.

### Additional Admission Requirements:

1. Music faculties require auditions or audition tapes;
2. Fine Arts faculties require portfolios;
3. Each university will have a list of approved grade 12 academic courses that they will accept for admission purposes. Please check their websites for the list.
4. Social sciences, childcare and human development faculties may require documented evidence of community service and experience;
5. Physical Education and related faculties may require performance and fitness testing;
6. TOEFL or IELTS scores are required from students whose first language is not English;
7. American institutions require SAT exam scores.
